DON SBIR/STTR Goals

- Primary Program Goals:
 - Use small business to develop innovative R&D that addresses DON need
 - Commercialize (Phase III) SBIR-developed technology into a DON platform or weapons/communication system, or for facilities use
- About the Program:
 - Acquisition Driven Process with Strong Technology Pull
 - \$300M+ annual funding supporting small business innovation/research
 - Wide range of SBIR/STTR topics driven by PEO/PM/FNC specific needs



DON SBIR/STTR Program

- DON participates in all 3 DoD SBIR/STTR BAA cycles per year (55% January, 40% May, & 5% in September (SBIR only))
- On average, 1-in-5 proposals receive Phase I award but this varies by topic and technology
- Centralized contracting center processes ~87% of DON contracts for faster award times and consistent interactions
- DON primarily uses Purchase Orders for Phase I and Cost Plus Fixed Fee contracts for Phase II
- Maximum award amounts up to \$225K Phase I and \$1.5M
 Phase II allowed through series of Base and Options
- Various commercialization assistance available during Phase II/Commercialization Readiness Program
- Highest rate of Commercialization for the SBIR/STTR programs in DoD/Federal government
